[The Role of Israel and the Church](#)
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This is a new Kingdom of God message delivered at Marietta Vineyard Church on March 3 2013. It teaches on "The Role of Israel and the Church" in the progression of the Kingdom of God from Genesis to Revelation with personal testimony of Rabbi Jay and modern day analogies.

Many people in our Church have had very little exposure to the doctrine that supports their Church sharing Passover and other Feasts at the Church. Are the Feasts Relevant or has the Church now replaced Israel. Is Israel part of the Church or is the Church new to the days following Jesus, Yeshua's Resurrection?

This heartwarming lesson supported by scripture exposes the need for Traditional Jews, Messianics and the Church to make a Paradigm Shift from a focus on people to God's Plan of Redemption and desire to bring all humanity into the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom of God is the GOAL, the TOUCHDOWN, the very purpose and will of God for humanity since he created this most magnificent world and planted the Garden of Eden for his children Adam and Eve.

But God chose to give us a choice to love him and obey his commandment or to lose the right to the Tree of Life. Adam and Eve sinned and were exiled from the Garden. God had to kill an animal as a covering/clothes for them as they now would live in a harsher world with pain, suffering death and Satan having domino of the Kingdoms of Earth. You will learn that Israel was a nation created from the Seed of Abraham because of his Faith. God would offer Israel the new Garden of Eden if only they would obey his laws. Just like Adam and Eve, Israel was offered blessings of the Garden for faithful obedience or the curses of pain and suffering for disobedience. Israel also was exiled from the land of Promise.

Often the Church focuses on Israel's Diaspora and shares an attitude that God rejected Israel and therefore they have become second place citizens in the Church. But this lessons helps us to understand that God is a God of Promise and Redemption. Just as he promised a Seed or Messiah to Adam and Eve at their exile from the Garden, God promised Israel a New Covenant where God himself would bring them into the future Kingdom with his laws in their heart and would guide them to follow his ways.

We learn in the Church age God is reuniting the Jews and the Gentiles into the Kingdom by Faith in the Prophesized seed of the women and the Jewish Messiah. Now both Jew and Gentile would be One New Man with the Kingdom in their Heart. Believers would work together to grow more spiritually mature in the Church and to bring others into the Kingdom by Faith. This is why Pentecost the Birth of the Church came after Passover but on the day celebrating the giving of the law to Israel. Obedient to the Law through submission to the Spirit.

The Gentiles would be grafted into the covenants of Israel. All the Appointed Times of the Lord the Feasts of Israel were now for them also, as their substance was found in what Jesus has done, is doing and will do to redeem humanity back home to the Paradise of God and the right to eat of the Tree of Life.

Soon Jesus will return as Messiah King. At Passover we celebrate his first coming as Messiah Suffering Servant. This lesson will provide the foundation that will open your heart to all the Feasts and Appointed Times of the Kingdom of God for both Israel and the Church in the Glory of Christ Jesus, Messiah Yeshua for all.
